STUDY PLAN

WEEK 1 - HOW TO COMPLAIN IN SPANISH

Start by introducing yourself and learn how to complain in Spanish. We'll start using the subjunctive tense.

WEEK 2 - ASK FOR ADVICE AND REACT

Let's use common phrases to express our emotions and react to different events.

WEEK 3 - A MEXICAN LEYEND/MYTH

Learn vocabulary related to a very popular Mexican leyend. Then you'll have to tell me one popular leyend of your country. We'll have fun!

WEEK 4 - DEBATE: ILLEGAL IMMIGRATION

It's time to debate. Learn or practice connection words and learn how to talk about a very tough topic

WEEK 5 - WHY DOES MEXICO HAVE THIS FLAG?

Mexico has an amazing story behind its flag. Your teacher is going to show you vocabulary and you'll practice preterite and imperfect tense.

WEEK 6 - LET'S PUT IN PRACTICE EVERYTHING YOU LEARNED

It's time to put into practice everything you learned. Your teacher is going to give you a topic and you have to present it to your classmates.
