

THRIVE IN SPANISH - BASIC CONVERSATION COURSE

A communicative Spanish course designed to make sure you have the tools you need to thrive in daily life in Mexico.

STUDY PLAN

WEEK 1 - GETTING TO KNOW YOU AND TALK ABOUT PLACES IN MEXICO

Introduce yourself. Then let's talk about places and how to ask for directions in Mexico. (Real words)

WEEK 2 - BUY A TICKET FOR A BUS/TRAIN IN MEXICO

Learn to use the Mexican phrases we use in Mexico to buy a ticket to travel by bus. Let's use the direct object and indirect object too.

WEEK 3 - AT A MEXICAN PARTY

Learn vocabulary related to a party. Learn Mexican phrases we use in a very casual event and you'll learn a new tense. Present continuous.

WEEK 4 - MY TRIP TO THE BEACH

Learn phrases to talk about those cool trips you've had and start using present perfect to express them.

WEEK 5 - AT THE DOCTOR IN MEXICO

What vocabulary do you have to use if you get sick in Mexico. How do you have to express your pain?

WEEK 6 - DAY OF THE DEATH IN MEXICO

What do Mexicans do on the Day of the Death? Learn and let's have a conversation about this cool tradition.

COURSE STRUCTURE

LIVE CLASS

Each week you will take one 75-minute class with a native speaker online and another 40-minute live class to practice with a native speaker who only speaks Spanish. These classes are designed to keep you talking as much as possible so that you build confidence and fluency.

VOCABULARY APP

Membership to this course gives you access to our courses vocabulary in the Quizlet app. Study the class vocabulary ahead of time so that you are ready to start speaking as soon as the class starts!

GOOGLE CLASSROOM
